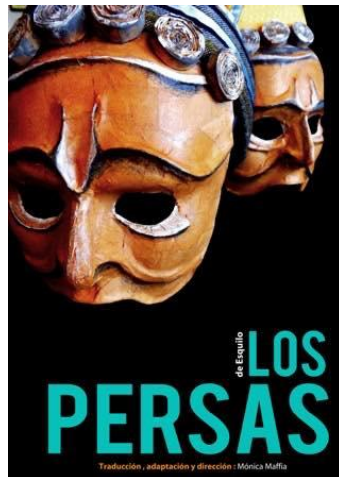
vii - Hoxton Hall. 'Suppliants of Syria' is a modern retelling of Aeschylus's Greek tragedy, 'Suppliants', one of the earliest classics to consider the politics of asylum.

The show transplants the traditionally Greek context into the narratives of Syrian refugee women living in Turkey, and quotes directly from Aeschylus's script to highlight historical references to the Mediterranean, Levant, and the idea of exodus.
