Athens

- i – Athens Revives Hadrian’s Aqueduct to Help With Water Crunch
- ii – Hermes Ludovisi style statue unearthed in a meter-wide trench to the south of the Odeon of Herodes Atticus, at the junction of Erechthiou and Kalliperi streets.
- iii – Days after the discovery of a stunning statue unearthed during work on the natural gas network in Athens near the Acropolis, new antiquities were unearthed during the ongoing excavations at the same location
- iv – Cycladic Museum Highlights Women Throughout History
- v - A dazzling exhibition of gold Hellenistic jewelry has been impressing visitors at the Benaki Museum in Athens since November and will continue to do so until April 2025.

N. Greece

- i – Two New Museums Will House the Archaeological Treasures of the Thessaloniki Metro Finds
- ii - The Guardian of Amphipolis: Full Documentary
Alexandros Kochliaridis, the “guardian of Amphipolis” is the first man to see the Amphipolis tomb

Peloponnese

- i – Cyclone Project - Preserving the ancient past, one plastic bottle at a time
7 month initiative removed 518 tons of waste from areas including the Mycenaean Acropolis & Asopos River delta, 15,397 kg from tholos tombs in Argolis & Treasury of Atreus
90% of the 684,014 collected items were non-recyclable.
- ii – Recent west of Aigio uncovered ancient building and a wealth of gold antiquities that archaeologists believe were part of the town of Rypes, referenced by Pausanias
- iii - A heroon with intact tombs filled with luxurious jewels and lions sculpted in Pentelic marble, found in the ancient Greek city of Ripes in Achaea
